Who?

Those of you who have successfully completed **Visual Art 3 in Year 11** are well placed to undertake **Art Studio Practice 3**.

Successful completion of **Art Studio Practice 3** can prepare you for the study of visual arts at tertiary level.

Entry Requirements: You must have achieved an SA or better in Visual Art 3 in Year 11 to enrol in this course.

How?

Work requirements:

Work submitted for assessment in **Art Studio Practice 3C** must be produced over the duration of one calendar school year, be unique to this course and not be work submitted for assessment in any other course. An exhibition of your years' work is externally assessed but there is NO external exam.

What?

Art Studio Practice 3 is a Year 12 subject and it has been designed to enable you to develop meaningful conceptual knowledge through research and studio practice.

You will negotiate a proposal for self-directed learning and are required to prepare a research paper, visual schematic overview, artist's statement and present an exhibition.

It will challenge you to engage in reflective and critical analysis to refine, evaluate and articulate your ideas in the consolidation of your artistic practice.

The course integrates knowledge and practice through active art investigation and participation in specialised and authentic learning experiences.

It provides a framework for you to establish links and actively engage with local, national and international art communities.
