- Use Japanese to communicate with others in spoken Japanese
- Use Japanese to read and respond to written Japanese texts
- Use Japanese to express ideas and information in written Japanese
- Gain a deeper understanding and appreciation of contemporary Japanese customs and daily life, and the cultural context in which Japanese is used
- Reflect on their own culture through the comparison of Australian and Japanese culture.

- Various assessment tasks that assess your developing reading, writing, speaking and listening skills
